

PARENTAL DISCIPLINE

Concerning parental discipline Solomon wrote: "He who spares the rod hates his son, but he who loves him is careful to discipline him" (Proverbs 13:24). "Do not withhold discipline from a child; if you punish him with the rod, he will not die. Punish him with the rod and save his soul from death" (Proverbs 23:13,14). "The rod of correction imparts wisdom, but a child left to himself disgraces his mother...Discipline your son, and he will give you peace; he will bring delight to your soul" (Proverbs 29:15,17).

Disciplining children is one of the most difficult tasks confronting new parents. It is never easy or pleasant, but it is essential to their well-being. For several years now discipline has been looked upon with disdain. It was thought to be counterproductive, creating fears and inhibitions, thus hindering a child's development. Some even argued that love prevented discipline, but the experts were wrong.

Discipline, like going to the dentist or having surgery, may not be pleasant, but it is good. First, it is an act of love. "He who loves him is careful to discipline him" (13:24). Second, discipline delivers, it does not destroy. "If

you punish him with the rod, he will not die," but you, "save his soul from death" (23:13,14). Third, discipline makes for peace and delight in later years. "Discipline your son, and he will give you peace; he will bring delight to your soul" (29:17).

The Bible demands discipline. Godly parents are neither permissive nor abusive, but they do discipline in love. Biblical discipline is loving and instructive. In no sense does the Bible support abuse, be it mental, physical, sexual, or emotional. In modern society the most common form of child abuse is neglect!
