

The apostle Paul wrote by inspiration: "For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works" (Titus 2:11-14 ESV).

The true test of discipleship is not simply a matter of whether or not we worship on the Lord's Day. The assembly of the saints is important, and we should be faithful in our worship (Hebrews 10:25). But it is possible to be present every time the doors of the meeting house are open, and still be a scoundrel.

As Christians we must live every day so that Christ is seen in us. When Peter and John defended themselves at Jerusalem, the record says: "Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated, common men, they were astonished. And they recognized that they had been with Jesus" (Acts 4:13). Until people see the imprint of Jesus on us in our homes, schools, communities, and workplaces, seeing us assembled with the church on the Lord's Day will not have the positive impact upon them that it should have, nor will it get us one step closer to heaven.
