NOT ASHAMED OF THE GOSPEL

Paul wrote to the Christians at Rome, "So as much as in me is, I am ready to preach the gospel to you that are at Rome also. For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek" (Romans 1:16, 17). He went everywhere preaching the word, and the disciples were multiplied.

Paul's success as a preacher cannot be attributed to his oratorical skills. As a public speaker he lacked much. His preaching was not with "excellency of speech or of wisdom," nor did he use "enticing words of man's wisdom" to entertain a crowd (1 Corinthians 2:1, 4). He proclaimed the pure and simple gospel of Jesus Christ. He believed in the power of preaching. It was he who wrote that "it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe" (1 Corinthians 1:21).

Preaching has fallen on hard times of late. John F. MacArthur, Jr., in his book, **Ashamed of the Gospel**, writes: "Traditional methodology--most notably preaching--is being discarded or down-played in favor of newer means, such as drama, dance, comedy, variety, side-show histrionics, pop-psychology, and other

The church is not in the entertainment business. The church is in the soul saving business, and only the gospel has the power to save souls.

We still believe in the power of the gospel. We preach God's word without apology. We seek to honor God and glorify Christ.
