GOOD NEWS SHOULD BE SHARRED

Suppose you encountered a man today at the corner of Third and Putnam Streets with what appeared to be an unlimited supply of thousand-dollar bills. He was handing out one per person, no strings attached, to all who passed by. What would your first impulse be? Would let your family know? Would you call friends and coworkers so they could share in the bounty? Or, would you keep this knowledge to yourself?

Jesus commissioned His disciples with these words: *“Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned”* (Mark 16:15, 16). The gospel, in Greek (euaggelion), literally means “good news.” Good news is meant to be shared. It’s not something we keep to ourselves, it’s something we shout from the roof tops.

We don’t know a great deal about Andrew, one of Jesus’ disciples, but we do know much about his brother, Peter. When Andrew discovered the good news about Jesus the first thing he did was find Peter, and brought him to the Lord (John 1:41, 42). When Philip heard the gospel he immediately went to Nathanael and said, *“We have found him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph”* (John 1:45). Andrew and Philip? They had good news and had to share it!
Jesus never intended for his disciples to be silent. He had a world vision, and a strategy for realizing His vision. They were to be witnesses of Him in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the world (Acts 1:8). Within a short time they had filled Jerusalem with His doctrine (Acts 5:28). When persecution came upon the church following the martyrdom of Stephen, we are told that “*they that were scattered abroad went everywhere preaching the word*” (Acts 8:4). Again, they had good news and could not be quiet about it.

If a gift of a thousand dollars is worth sharing with others, how much more so is the story of the priceless gift of Jesus? When we really believe He was the Son of God, and that He died to save us, we will immediately obey Him and tell others about it. It is news too good to be kept to ourselves. Do you believe? Have you been baptized? Are you sharing the good news with others? Our spiritual well-being, and that of those around us, demands that we do all three.
