If big crowds and large contributions are all that is important, then I suggest that there are better ways to accomplish both. Major league sporting events, for the most part, can draw crowds and raise money. A great church is not great because of its budget or its big crowds.

Great churches are great because of their faith in the greatness of God. Paul commended the church at Colosse for their "faith in Christ Jesus" (Colossians 1:4). Great churches put their trust in the gospel, not in gimmicks. It is the gospel which is God's power to save (Romans 1:16).

Great churches are great because of their love. The church at Philippi was a loving church. They were encouraged to abound in love (Philippians 1:9). Great churches have members who love God with all their heart, soul, and mind
