Yahweh: The Holy Name of God

In most translations, God's name in the Old Testament is simply translated as LORD. You might notice that as you read through your Scriptures there are times when *Lord* is either all caps (LORD) or capitalized traditionally (Lord). **YHWH** is translated as "LORD" and **Adonai** is translated as "Lord." The reason for the two styles is found in the differences of the underlying words.

If you are an astute observer, you would have recognized that in my sermons and Bible studies I read the name "Yahweh." This is because of the translation I use—The LSB. As is said in the preface, translating Yahweh "...allows proper distinction between God's personal name and the title, 'Lord' (*Adonai*), which emphasizes God's authority. Even more, it helps the reader to engage God with the name which he gifted to his people. Thus, the reintroduction of God's personal name into the translation of the OT is a feature that enhances the precision, intensity, and clarity of the biblical text in English" (*Legacy Standard Bible, PREFACE II*).

God's name is important. God spoke to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM...thus you

shall say to the sons of Israel, 'Yahweh, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you.' This is my name forever, and this is my memorial name from generation to generation" (Exodus 3:14, 15). Again, God spoke to Moses, "I am Yahweh; and I appeared to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, as God Almighty, but by my name, Yahweh, I was not known to them" (Exodus 6:2-3).

God's powerful name has been given to us! Not only as a memorial to be remembered forever, but also as a revelation into who he himself is. And this name shall ring forth forever, to all generations, to all peoples, everywhere. By his name we have assurance of deliverance (Exodus 3:14), hope in trial (Psalm 23), an eternal foundation amidst changing times (John 8:58), and so much more.

Friends, I know there is much to be concerned about in this world. You go through trials and tribulations, storms of chaos, times of despair, and days of depression. But the God who delivered a people out of Egypt, who split the red sea, who conquered the false gods of the Canaanites, who led his people into safe pasture, and who came to this earth to suffer and die, is the same God who stands by you and for you today! When you need a comforter, hear Yahweh's words, "I AM." When you need a deliverer, hear the words, "I AM." When you need a savior, hear the precious words of our God, "I AM."

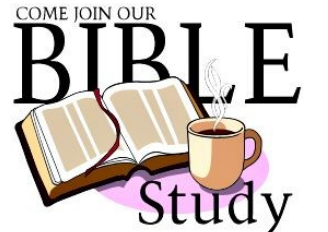
