And let the man depart in peace.

Pilate, like other men, was weak—

He did not have the force to speak,

And say that Christ should be set free.

But let him suffer on the tree.

I think that he who has the power,
That's needed in a trying hour;
And fails that power to exercise—
Stands guilty in our Savior's eyes.
And hence I think, no doubt, but he,
Who had the power to set him free—
Committed murder in his heart,
As much as though he'd cast the dart.
I have no use for men like these,
Who try so hard both sides to please;
Who, rather than destroy their plans,
Turn 'round and wash their dirty
hands!

What a choice we must make! Those who have fallen away in heart crucify Christ afresh by their actions of unfaithfulness (Hebrews 6:6); they put him to an open shame. Like Pilate, they acquiesce to the accusers of Christ. They know who Christ truly is, but for the sake of retaining their position in life, they deny him.

Those who allow Christ to be set free within their hearts are instead, in a spiritual sense, crucified with him (Galatians 2:20; 5:24). They experience the wonderful peace of God (John 14:27) and receive all spiritual blessings through Christ.

Let it be known, we cannot wash ourselves of our iniquities. We do not have the

power to clean our blood-soaked hands. Do not think that you can deny Christ in your actions but affirm him with your lips. Do not think that you can kill Christ by your decisions but set him free in your heart. Under no circumstances should you think that you can play both sides of the trial. The enormous choice is yours. Kill Christ or set him free.
