example. However, beliefs that will influence our entire lives must be deeply considered.

Listen to the words of Jesus:

Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple. For which one of you, when he wants to build a tower, does not first sit down and calculate the cost to see if he has enough to complete it? Lest, when he has laid a foundation and is not able to finish, all who observe it begin to ridicule him, saying, This man began to build and was not able to finish.' Or what king, when he sets out to meet another king in battle, will not first sit down and consider whether he is strong enough with ten thousand men to encounter the one coming against him with twenty thousand? Or else, while the other is still far away, he sends a delegation and asks for terms of peace. So then, none of you can be my disciple who does not give up all his own possessions. (Luke 14:27-33)

What was Jesus meaning by this? Simply, Jesus is urging us to seek deeper meaning before we make our decisions in life. Consider the impact that a belief or decision will have on your life, count the cost, weigh it out, ask the questions, search for answers, and then make the decision.

I must confess, I have seen many people throw themselves into careers, life altering medical procedures, and even religions without so much as asking the question why. Many times, these people become discouraged and end up with ruined careers, devastating health problems, and become apostates. Do not follow this line of reasoning: "If it was good enough for my

Think as an individual. Ask the important questions and make a decision that is based on your own study and meditation.

Jesus wants us to know why we believe what we believe, and why we do what we do. If Jesus himself asked you today, "Why do you follow me?" would you be able to give him a proper answer?
