Jesus. They will pay the penalty of eternal destruction from the Lord's presence and from his glorious strength... (2 Thessalonians 1:5-9)

From the above passage we observe that God will both punish evil doers for their affliction and relieve those who are afflicted for the sake of Christ. However, this will happen on the last day. On that day complete judgment will be brought forth; full justice will be delivered.

The scriptures should remind us that God will do what is right: *"He will wipe away every tear from their eyes. Death will be no more; grief, crying, and pain will be no more, because the previous things have passed away. Then the one seated on the throne said, 'Look, I am making everything new'"* (Revelation 21:4-5).

For those of you who may be hurting from injustice, it will be resolved. For those who need comfort for your afflictions, it will be given. For all who are trying to run away from God and the consequences of disobedience, you will be found.
