And They Were All Astonished At The Majesty of God

Luke records an account of a demon possession which occurred with a man's son (9:37-42). The son was the only boy that the father had. This demon had caused much harm to the boy. It caused him to have seizures, foam at the mouth, scream, and the demon "mauled him as it left" (v. 39). The father, being left with no other choice, took it upon himself to beg the disciples of Jesus to cast it out, but they were unable to (v. 40).

When the father saw Jesus, he told him of these happenings. After Jesus lamented at the unbelief of the generation he found himself in, he commanded the man to bring the boy to him (v. 41). In the midst of a massive crowd, as the father was bringing the boy to Jesus, the demon within him became active again and "slammed him to the ground and threw him into a convulsion," but Jesus rebuked the spirit causing the spirit's departure and the boy was returned back to his father healed (v. 42).

What a scene this must have been! The drama that fills every word of this **Continued on Page 3**

story is riveting, and the suspense crawls upon our minds as we read. In person, surely this would bring shock and awe. The reaction of the crowd is recorded by Luke— "And they were all astonished at the majesty of God" (v. 43).

Make no mistake, God's majesty is displayed in his rule over all things in heaven and on earth. His majesty, and Christ's majesty is exhibited in great power over all the dark forces of this world. However, I submit to you, that in the silent realms of what others see as insignificant, God's majesty shines forth there as well.

When a leaf falls to the ground, the majesty of God is shown. When the sun rises and sets, the majesty of God is proclaimed. When the snow falls upon the earth, the majesty of God is displayed. When the rain comes, when floods occur, when seasons change, when animals feed their young—when anything good that is designed by God takes place—the majesty of God has gone forth.

Are we astonished at the majesty of God? Does God's majesty cause us to bow in praise? Let us always recognize the majesty of God in our lives.
