He who would be great!

The apostle Paul warned: "For I say, through the grace given to me, to every one who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith" (Romans 12:3). For those tempted to think more highly of themselves than they should, I am reminded of what the mother whale said to her baby: "When you get to the top and start to 'blow' that's when you get harpooned."

At the close of the European phase of WW II, General George Patton was having a conversation with General Omar Bradley. Patton was concerned that now that the battle in Europe was ending, there would be no more need for his services. Bradley assured Patton that that was not so. There was still a battle to be fought in the Pacific, and General Douglas MacArthur would be glad to have his help. Patton replied, "No, Mac-Arthur wouldn't have me. all the way to the top." Then Patton added, "MacArthur never forgave me for that."

Everybody wants to be somebody! Ambition is not necessarily a bad thing. But, there is always the danger that we will become too full of ourselves. Israel's first king, suffered from the "big head." He came to the throne when he was "little in his own sight" (1 Samuel 15:17). He lost the throne because he thought he could overrule God (2 Samuel 15:23).

Sadly, most do not know what constitutes true greatness. Jesus can enlighten us on the subject. He said, "...but whosoever will be great among you, let him be your minister. And whosoever will be chief among you, let him be your servant" (Matthew 20:26, 27). If we would be great, we must learn to serve. It's a lesson we all need to learn.
