

"Passover lamb." They roasted and ate it, applying the blood of the lamb to the door posts and lintels of their homes. The first born in every home where the blood had been applied lived, but all others died. The Passover Feast served thereafter as a memorial (a monument) to the night Israel secured her freedom.

It was at the observance of the Passover memorial that an even greater monument was erected to the Lamb of God! On the night Jesus was betrayed He met with his disciples, and during that meeting instituted the Lord's Supper. Through the unleavened bread and grape juice, we are forever reminded of the broken body and shed blood of our redeemer. He asked that no other monument be erected to His memory. He sought no ornate cathedral or marble likeness. He asked only that His memory be kept alive through the simple act of communion around His table each Lord's Day.

As great as our debt to our war dead may be, we are greater debtors to the one who died at Calvary to provide for our freedom from sin and its condemnation. We should not let a Sunday pass without remembering His sacrifice around His table. Will you be among the faithful who assemble around the Lord's table this Lord's Day, and every Lord's Day, to remember Christ and His sacrifice on the cross?
