

A SIGN OF THE TIMES

Rob Bell is the "Pastor" of the Mars Hill Bible Church. Located in Michigan, Sunday morning attendance at Mars Hill runs about 7,000. It is described as a non-traditional congregation emphasizing discussion over dogmatism. The church, and in particular its preacher, has received a lot of attention of late.

Preacher Bell has written a book: Love Wins: A Book About Heaven, Hell, and the Fate of Every Person Who Ever Lived. If you believe the Bible then don't bother with Bell's book. It seems that Rob Bell has decided that hell is inconsistent with the redemptive work of Jesus. Bell comes from an Evangelical background which makes his book all the more newsworthy. Evangelicals generally claim to believe in the inspiration, authority, and all-sufficiency of Scripture. If Bell did hold such a view of Scripture, it is clear that he no longer does.

One cannot believe that the Bible is the inspired word of God, and that Jesus was the Son of God, while at the same time rejecting the message of both. Jesus said: "And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell" (Matthew 10:28). He had a lot more to say on the subject, but that one statement refutes the premise of

Bell's book. As a Christian, we must take what the BOOK says over anything other books say.

Bell's denial of hell is not the result of ambiguity in Scripture regarding the subject, but is the direct outcome of a postmodern society which believes it knows more than an "outdated" book like the Bible. In this postmodern society truth is relative. Everything is subject to debate and multiple interpretations.

Tolerance is what matters. Intolerance must not be tolerated. If sin exists at all, it is the sin of intolerance. Everyone is entitled to his/her own opinion, and who is to say that one opinion is better than another. After all, the Bible says "judge not, that you be not judged." Don't question what others say or feel. Just accept people as they are. Learn to get along. Love everybody with a feel good, non-judgmental, accepting love. There is no right or wrong, black or white, everything is just a fuzzy shade of gray.

Rob Bell hasn't discovered new insights into an old subject. The rejection of hell is the natural outcome of postmodern theology. If one can dismiss what the scriptures say about male leadership in the church (1 Corinthians 14:34; 1 Timothy 2:11, 12), homosexuality, adultery and fornication (1 Corinthians 6:9-11), or the essentially of baptism (Mark 16:16), then it is not a problem to set aside what it says about hell.

Does God want anyone to be lost? Of course not! Jesus came to "seek and save the lost" (Luke 19:10). God "desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth" (1 Timothy 2:4). Peter wrote: "The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance" (2 Peter 3:9).

Hell is real. Denying it is just a sign of the times! Don't be mislead by those who say otherwise.
