

### **Bill's Bytes**

A common experience of this life is receiving wounds, we will all have a broken heart, or maybe a crushed spirit occasionally. If you are not wounded right now, then you likely have scars of past wounds. It is probable that you have both fresh wounds and old scars.

Of course, we are not speaking of physical wounds or scars - though depending on the trauma behind them, they too may leave a lasting mark that goes far past the depth of our skin and bone. A variety of challenges can take their toll on us differently, and many of them will leave us heartbroken: financial difficulties, a friend's betrayal, unrequited love, a failed marriage, and of course the death of a loved one.

How you deal with these injuries is a large part of the process of how you develop as a person. Some of us refuse to let their wounds heal and scar. We keep picking at them, allowing the festering of embitterment to settle in and infect our hearts and minds. On the other hand, we may believe that we can heal ourselves, but that often causes more harm than good. The actions that we often

think we need to take to alleviate the symptoms will not get to the root cause, and may serve to make things worse.

There is another way, however. Most do not take it serious, and many others will not fully realize its benefits. Of course, this is the way of Christ. We often err in our understanding of salvation and sin, and therefore life itself. The blood of Jesus is more than just our "ticket to heaven." It is able penetrate to our very heart, mind and soul. Christ does not ignore our wounds, He is able to heal them. Just think, if He has the power to heal our spiritual ailments, then we know that He can heal our whole person as well. The scars will still be there for sure, but scars serve to remind us that we have been strengthened through what we have survived. In time, our faith in God though Christ will remind us that though our hearts are broken, and our spirits are crushed, God can put us back together—He is the Master of restoration after all! We understand that even though bad things do happen we will someday see how it all worked together in God's plan. We know that because of Him we have victory over this present age of sin, death and darkness. Read and consider Psalm 34.18, First John 5.4 and Romans 8.
