the eyes of the world. One pervasive thing in our culture is the pursuit of athletic excellence. Time, money, and often even a relationship with God are sacrificed to grasp the often empty promises that athletics offer.

However, there is a greater pursuit that leads to lasting fulfillment and eternal value—the pursuit of a relationship with Christ. Jesus said in Matthew 6:33, "But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." When we prioritize our relationship with Christ, we find true satisfaction and purpose.

In Philippians 3:7-8, Paul wrote, "But whatever were gains to me I now consider loss for the sake of Christ. What is more, I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things." Paul recognized that the greatest treasure is knowing Christ and being found in Him.
